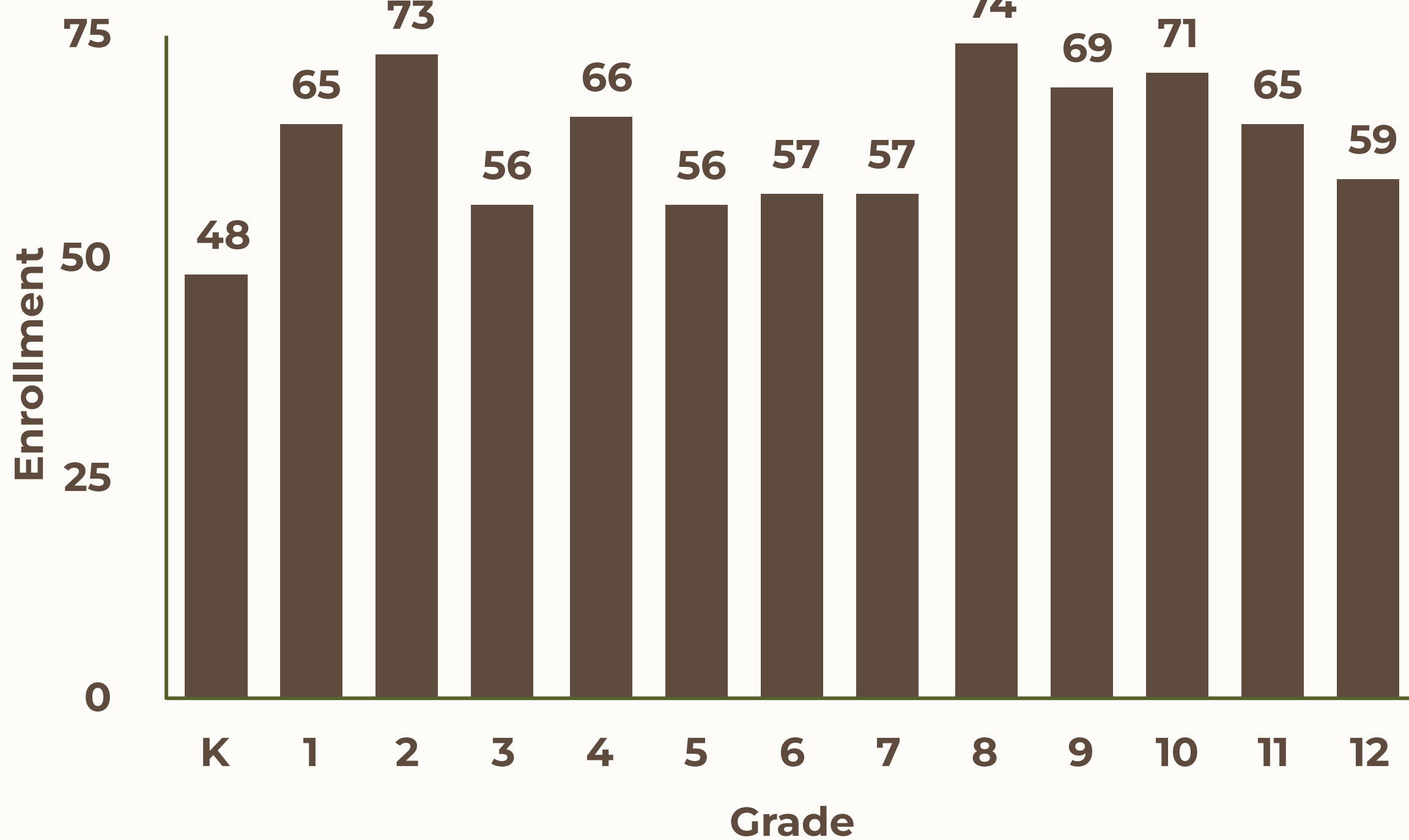


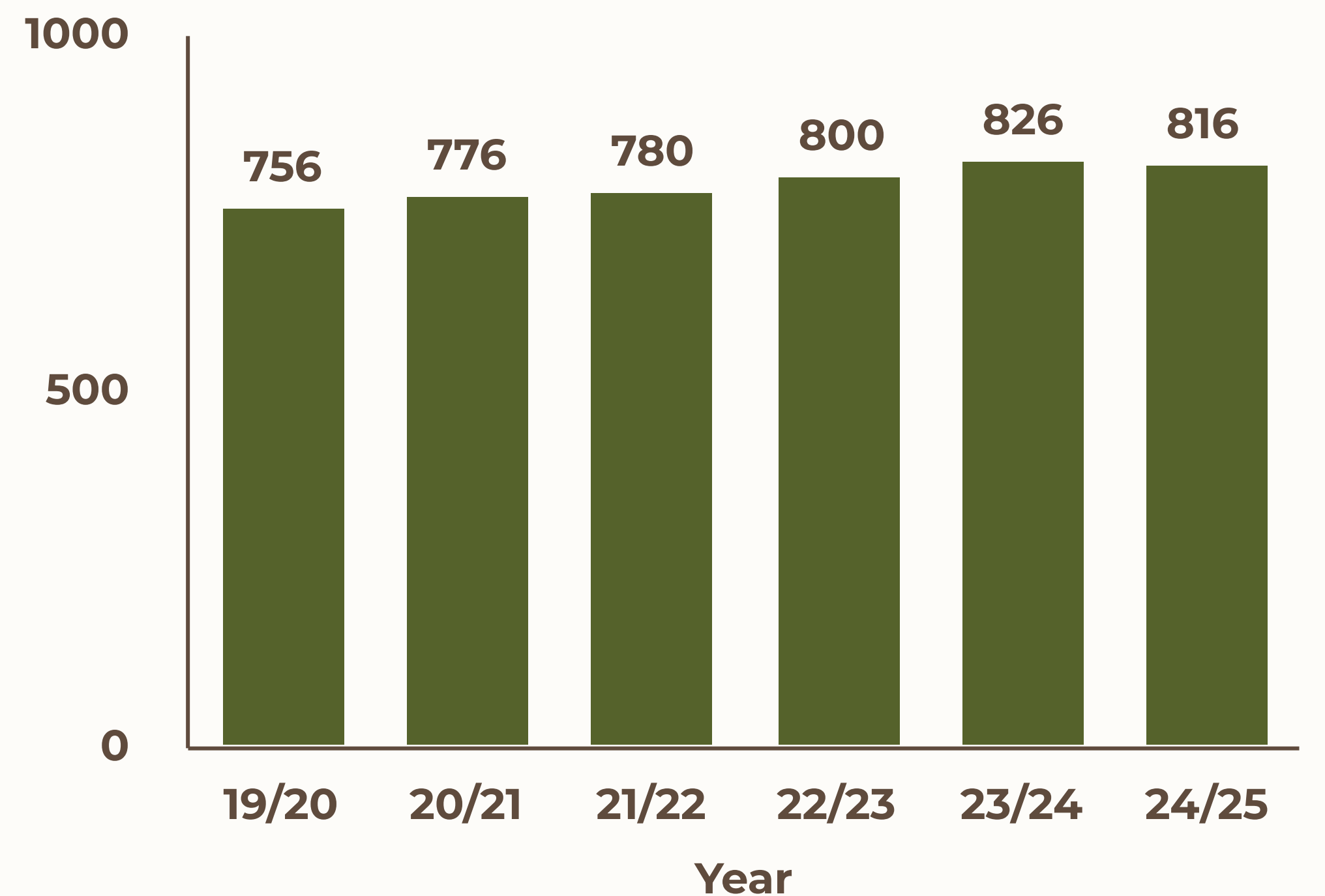

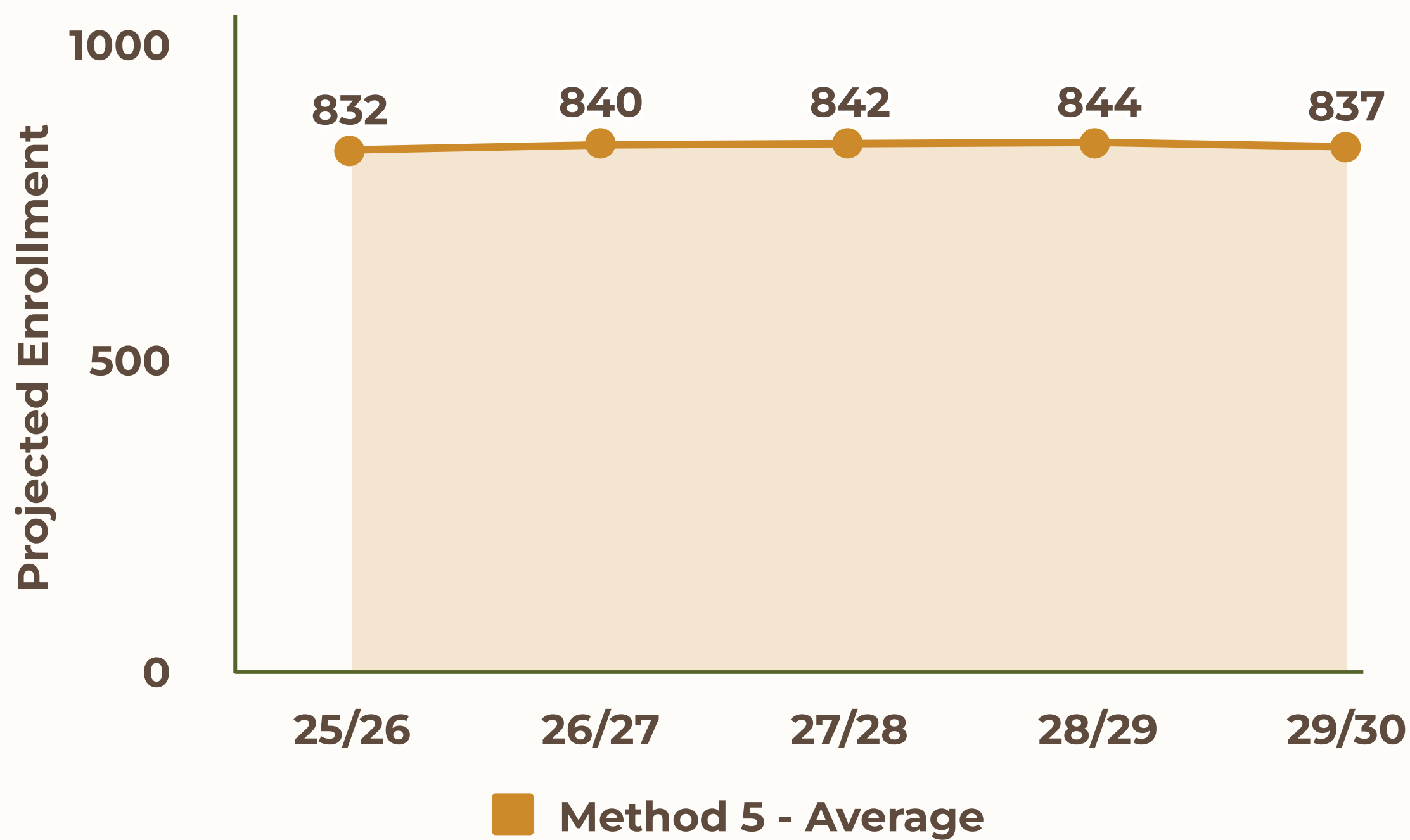
2024-25 Enrollment – 816 Students



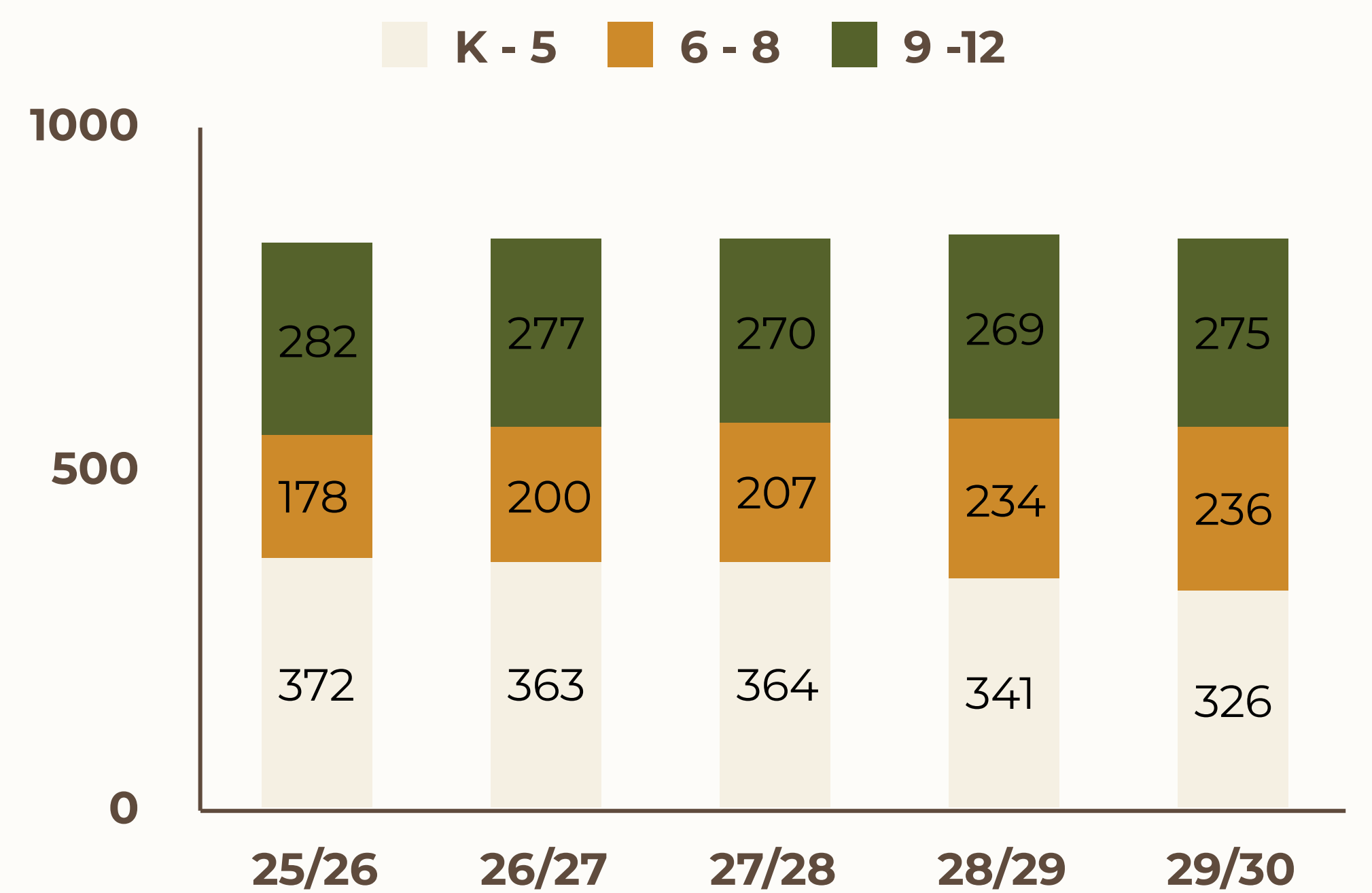
Past Enrollment



5-Year Projection Average



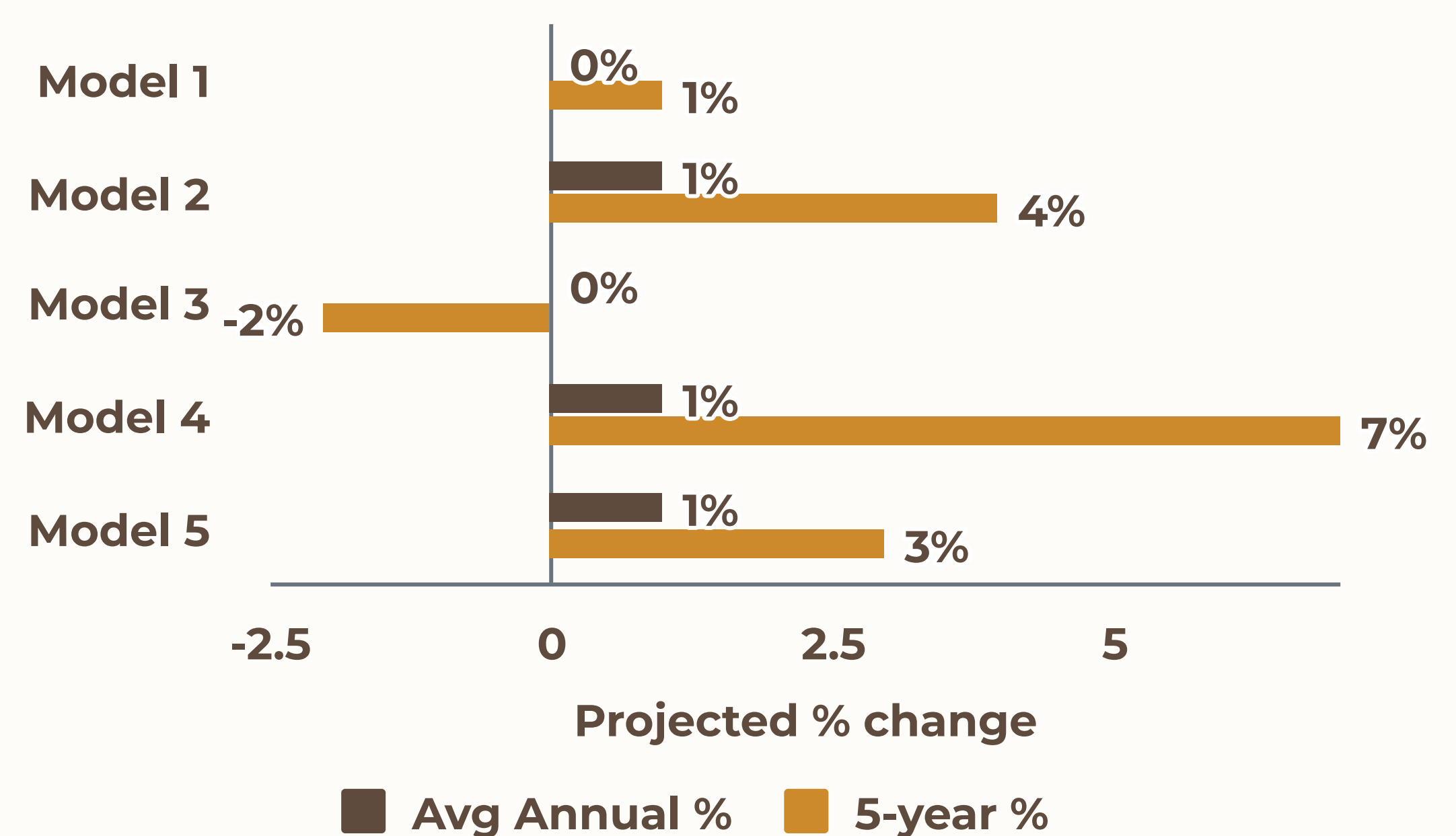
Average by Grade Band



Highlights

Sample School District is expected to see an *average* enrollment increase of 3% over the next five years. Projections range from a -2% change to a +7% change over the coming five year period. For your district, projection model 3 provides the most conservative approach while model 4 is the most aggressive.

National enrollment projection methods have evolved. Traditional reliance on birth data and cohort survival methods are no longer sufficient for a variety of reasons.

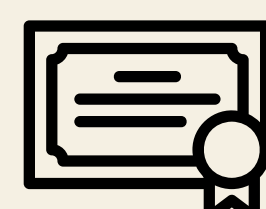

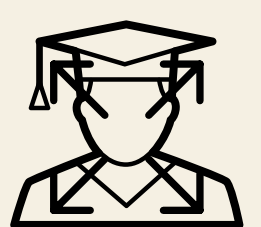
